**ALL ROADS
LEAD TO
HEAVEN**

There is a popular belief today that no matter what we may believe about God (or no matter what “god” we serve) we can get to Heaven; that “all roads lead to Heaven.” Is this really true? How is it that all these religions which contradict each other, and many of which teach that the others do not lead to Heaven, can all get you to Heaven? They all cannot be true. Jesus says, “I am THE way, THE truth, and THE life” and that “no one can come to the Father EXCEPT THROUGH ME” (John 14:6). Jesus says no other religion or god can give you eternal life except for Biblical Christianity, and He proves that this is the case through His resurrection (Acts 17:30-31). If you died today, would you be right with the God of the Bible? If you have lied, stolen, used God’s name in vain, looked with lust, hated someone, you have broken God’s laws (sinned). You stand before God right now as a lying thief, a blasphemer, an adulterer (Matt. 5:28), and a murderer (1 John 3:15). Your sin separates you from God, the source of spiritual life. You are dead spiritually and are deserving of His wrath. But this is not what God desires for you. God sent His Son (Jesus) to this earth to be a sacrifice for your sins. He died for you and was raised from His tomb by God so you can have the hope of eternal life. If you believe this message (the Gospel), confess Jesus Christ as Lord, and turn from your sins, God will raise you out of the hopeless state of death you are in, wash away your sins, and give you new life when you are baptized (Ephesians 2:1-10; Romans 6:1-7; Colossians 2:11-14).
